- ◆ 1 pack crayons (24 count)
- 1 pair blunt-nose scissors (not pointed)
- 2 pencils (#2)
- ◆ 1 small, manual pencil sharpener
- ♦ 2 glue sticks
- ◆ 1 tub of Play-Doh (regular sized)
- 1 composition book (wide ruled)
- 5 sheets of construction paper (multiple colors)
