Last year (2013/2014), programs supported by United Way's Community Impact Fund provided services to

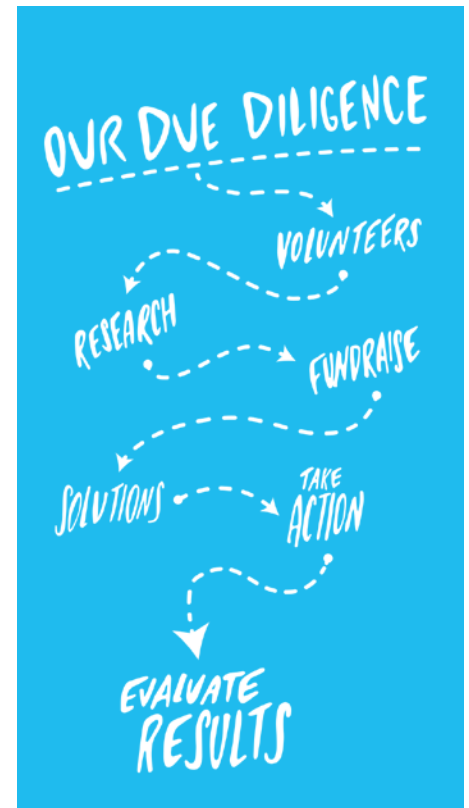
