- 4. Use online tools like **Amazon Wishlist** or SignUp Genius.
- 5. Consider partnering with Barnes & Noble through a <u>book fair</u>. It's an easy way to direct your supporters to preferred books and a percentage of the sale will go to United Way.
- 6. Spread the word. Start with your own personal or professional networks. Empower other advocates to help spread the word.
- 7. After you have finished your drive, bring everything to United Way. The donation deadline is March 22, 2019.
