### Host your own literacy kit drive in 7 easy steps

2. Let us know about your drive by emailing [volunteer@yourunitedway.org](mailto:volunteer@yourunitedway.org). This will help us make sure we are going to reach our target of 1,500 kits and we can drop off United Way collections boxes for you.
3. Use United Way's [sample email](#), [customizable flyer](#) and [suggested social media posts](#). Customize to your audience and be specific on why you are collecting these materials.
4. Use online tools like [Amazon Wishlist](#) or SignUp Genius.
5. Consider partnering with Barnes & Noble through a [book fair](#). It's an easy way to direct your supporters to preferred books and a percentage of the sale will go to United Way.
6. Spread the word. Start with your own personal or professional networks. Empower other advocates to help spread the word.
7. After you have finished your drive, bring everything to United Way. The donation deadline is March 22, 2019.
