



# **WOMENRISE PROGRAM OVERVIEW**

- Women United came together to help start the program.
- An award of up to \$15,000 for single mothers to help them earn a degree/credential and advance towards family sustaining employment.
- Financial assistance paid to the childcare provider or other approved the vendor.



# WOMENRISE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Be a single female head of household with custody of at least one child
- Be enrolled or have plans to enroll in an education or career training program that results in a degree or credential
- Reside in the United Way of Greater Richmond &
  Petersburg region (Charles City, Chesterfield, Colonial
  Heights, Dinwiddie, Goochland, Hanover, Henrico, Hopewell,
  New Kent, Petersburg, Prince George, Powhatan, Richmond)



# **WOMENRISE SELECTION PROCESS**

- Applications due by 5/15
- Phone Screening and Virtual Interviews
- Selecting scholars with:
  - Have an educational plan to complete a degree or credential.
  - On a path towards family sustaining employment.

# **WOMENRISE SELECTION PROCESS**

- Extensive Application due by 5/15
- Notification emails starting the evening of Tuesday 6/3
- Phone screening Thursday 6/5 or Saturday 6/7
- Virtual Interviews by first come first serve scheduling Monday 6/9 through Wednesday 6/25



# **WOMENRISE ONBOARDING PROCESS**

- Notification emails starting the evening of Tuesday July 1.
- Must sign an agreement.
- Must submit invoices/bill for expenses.
- All expenses subject to approval by United Way.
- Must be payable by credit card, check or ACH monthly for an approved vendor.
- All childcare providers must be licensed or regulated.
- > \$15,000 or less of financial assistance.
